You must notify the Fixtures/Competitions Secretary with the result of a game within **SEVEN DAYS** of the fixture taking place. The only valid form of notification is by sending the **WHITE COPY** of your scoresheet by post to the relevant official. Please see the Competition Rules (below) for details of the fines that can be incurred by late delivery of score sheets.

## Medway Basketball Association Regulations

1. The Association and its individual members are subject to the England Basketball Regulations as published from time to time. Where these Regulations conflict with the England Basketball Regulations, these Regulations shall apply. Participation in the Medway Basketball Association Competitions signifies acceptance of these Regulations and agreement to abide by them.
2. All Club Secretaries have a duty and responsibility to administer their Club in an efficient and effective manner, in order to contribute to the smooth running of the Association's competitions. As part of this, they are required to notify the Management Committee of all relevant information in a timely fashion.

The Association and Management Committee, separately, shall have power to pass a Resolution (by at least a 50%/75% majority, respectively) that any member of The Association cease to be a participant in any particular competition. Such Resolution shall take effect from the conclusion of the meeting at which it is passed or from such later time as the Association or Management Committee decide.

If any Member Club wishes to resign as a participant in any Competition of The Association, then they should write to the General Secretary and the Management Committee may accept that resignation on payment of all subscriptions and fees (if any) then due and owing by that Member Club. In the event of default by a club, each player in that Competition must pay a proportion of the sum owed by their club, before they will be permitted to play in any of the Association's competitions.

### 3. Competition Membership & Club and Player Registrations

**a)** All Clubs must apply for entry into each relevant competition at each AGM for the following Season (or direct to the Management Committee in the case of late entries). The Management Committee shall have the discretion to admit new Clubs to any particular competition after the AGM, providing such Clubs meet any conditions and pay any such fees or costs as the Management Committee shall in its absolute discretion determine. Member clubs may enter the relevant competitions on payment of the following entry fees determined at an Annual General Meeting:

#### **Annual Entry Fee**

- Senior Club = £105.00
- Junior Club = £20.00 (to be charged to all Junior Clubs wishing to compete in only in Junior Competitions run by the Association.)
- Plus a £30.00 guarantee fee (which is refundable at the end of the season subject to there having been no fundamental breaches of the Association's Rules. Please note, ordinary default fines are payable separately and will not be taken out of the Guarantee Fee.)

The Management Committee shall have authority to allow entry by and to set fees for non-member Clubs wishing to participate in the Association's Competitions.

All entry and guarantee fees must be received by the Association's Treasurer at the AGM. Failure to do so will result in a 50% surcharge being added to all fees payable. Any Member Club withdrawing after 31 July will forfeit their Entry Fee. Any Member Club whose Fees have not been received by the Treasurer by 1 September will be expelled from the Association and shall forfeit any guarantee fees held by the Association.

**b)** Each Club, player and official must be registered with England Basketball to participate in the Association's Competitions. Where a Club/player/official has not registered through the Association, evidence of registration must be provided to the Management Committee before participation in the Association's competitions will be permitted.

**c)** Registration numbers for players, coaches and referees must be shown on the score sheet. The referees must ensure that this is done before the match starts.

#### **4. Administrative Penalties & Fines**

The Management Committee shall have full authority to impose such fines and penalties for any breach of the letter or spirit of these regulations or those of England Basketball, the Competition Rules or conduct which brings the game into disrepute, as it sees fit, such fines/penalties to be based upon:

- The nature of the matter and any relevant circumstances (including the consequences, actions of the party concerned before and after the matter, whether the matter has occurred previously etc.)
- Precedents.
- An appropriate type and severity of penalty to deter the party concerned from future misconduct.
- Recent conduct of the party.

Notwithstanding the above, the following penalties/fines shall be imposed in the circumstances described, unless the Committee determines that a different penalty is appropriate:

- i. Failure to register Club prior to the start of the season – suspension until registration.
- ii. For a Club which registers direct with EB or through another Area: Failure to supply club and player registration details to the MBA Registrar – suspension until details are supplied.
- iii. Playing a player not registered with the EBBA – £20.00 fine and loss of the game by forfeit.
- iv. Failure to send a representative to an Officials or Pre-Season seminar – £30.00 fine.
- v. Failure to attend a General Meeting – £30.00 fine.
- vi. Failure to comply with a Management Committee ruling or failure to reply to correspondence from a Management Committee Member – £10.00 fine.
- vii. The Disqualification of a player, a coach, a team follower or a club official will result in an automatic ban from participating in their team's next 2 Medway Basketball Association matches (in any capacity). Each situation will then be considered by the Disciplinary Officer to determine whether a higher penalty is warranted or whether the matter should be referred to the Disciplinary Panel. A coach or player under suspension for a match may not play in the match, act as team coach (or assistant coach), sit on the team bench as a team follower, or communicate with the team from

15 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the match, until after the end of the match. They may be present in the arena as a spectator unless otherwise stated by the Disciplinary Officer. The Disciplinary Officer may also take action in respect of the outcome of a game (e.g. order replay, deduct points, declare void, etc.) as he sees fit.

- viii. Clubs, coaches, players, team followers and club officials may be fined and/or suspended as considered appropriate for any other breach of these Rules or conduct which brings the game into disrepute. The Disciplinary Officer may also take action in respect of the outcome of a game (e.g. order replay, deduct points, declare void, etc.) as he sees fit.

Fines not received within 14 days of the official letter imposing the fine will be doubled. All outstanding fines must be paid immediately prior to the AGM for a Team to be eligible to participate in the Association's Competitions in the following Season. Club officials and coaches bear a special responsibility to set an example of good behaviour.

## 5. Clubs

In the event of a club fielding two or more teams in the same competition:

**a)** It must distinguish between first and second team etc., the first team playing in the higher Division if applicable.

**b)** Where the teams play in different divisions, the club must inform the Fixtures Secretary before the start of the season of their seven best players who will play in the first team only – not transferable unless they have the Management Committee's authority. The remaining club players may play for any of the Club's teams. However, if a player appears on a first team score sheet more than three times, he will be deemed a first team player and thus not transferable. Where the teams play in the same division, players may only play in one team in any particular season and the Club Secretary must notify the Fixtures Secretary which team each player will play for before the start of the season.

## 6. Club Details To Be Submitted To The Association

Clubs must supply the MBA Management Committee with such information as it may reasonably require, in whatever format and timescales as are requested.

## 7. Player Transfers

No player shall represent a club during the current season if he has already played for another Club during that same season unless prior written permission is obtained from the MBA Management Committee and the player's former club.

## 8. Disciplinary Matters

**a)** Disciplinary Matters related to misconduct by Players, Coaches, Match Officials, Team Followers and other Club Officials occurring during or immediately prior to or following matches shall be the responsibility of the Disciplinary Officer. The Chairman, or Vice Chairman, or in the case of a Central Venue League or One Day Tournament the Competition Organiser or a Member of the Management Committee present, may exercise the authority of the Disciplinary Officer in his absence.

**b)** For Simple matters requiring disciplinary action, the Disciplinary Officer shall impose an appropriate penalty. The Disciplinary Officer may consult one or two other Committee Members if he considers it appropriate.



**c)** For Complex or serious matters the Disciplinary Officer shall convene a Disciplinary Panel, consisting of at least three independent members of the Management Committee, which shall have full authority to take disciplinary action and to make recommendations for the future. A Disciplinary Panel may conduct its business by telephone or exchange of e-mail if appropriate. The Management Committee may also consider any disciplinary matter brought before it (in which case any Committee member with an interest in the matter at hand shall not take part in the decision making process)

**d)** Matters that are considered excessive will be passed directly to England Basketball for action.

**e)** Each referee is required to submit a written report in respect of any disciplinary matter and each club and any individual may also submit written reports if they so choose, all such reports to be submitted within 5 working days of the incident. If a person is guilty of misconduct not involving disqualification, which any of the match officials consider to be of sufficient gravity to warrant consideration by the Association, a report should be submitted by them as soon as possible and the Club concerned notified accordingly.

**f)** Disciplinary matters will be considered as soon as practicable.

**g)** It is not the normal practice for a personal hearing to be given by the Disciplinary Officer/Disciplinary Panel, although a personal hearing may be requested in the case of an appeal.

**h)** The reasons for imposing a fine or penalty will be documented in the notification of the fine/penalty.

**i) Appeals**

- i. There is a right of appeal against any automatic penalty or against any fine or decision of the Disciplinary Officer, Disciplinary Panel or Management Committee, such appeal to be received by the Disciplinary Officer within 7 days of notification (or the incident in the case of an automatic penalty), accompanied by written grounds for the appeal and an appeal fee of £30.00. Appeals may only be considered where the Chairman of the Appeal Panel considers that the appellant is directly affected by the decision.
- ii. In the event of an appeal being lodged, all fines and penalties which are the subject of the appeal will be suspended, until the appeal is heard, except in exceptional circumstances.
- iii. Appeals will be heard by 3 neutral senior basketball personnel drawn from a panel appointed by the Management Committee. The Chairman of the Appeal Panel will be appointed by the Chairman of the Association.
- iv. If the Appeal Panel so decides, the appellant together with any other party or parties who may be affected by the decision may be granted a personal hearing at the sole discretion of the Appeal Panel. Normally a personal hearing will be granted in cases relating to disciplinary action. In the case of a personal hearing, the appellant may be accompanied by one person of their choice. The expenses incurred by the appellant and anyone accompanying them are their responsibility.
- v. Decisions of the Appeal Panel are subject only to appeal to the EBBA. Any other party adversely affected by the decision may still exercise a right of appeal to the Appeal Panel provided they were not a party to the original appeal.

- vi. At the conclusion of the Appeal Panel Hearing, the Appeal Panel shall determine whether the Appeal Fee is returned to the appellant in full, in part or not at all. In addition the appellant may be liable for such of the costs and/or expenses of convening the Appeal Panel Hearing, up to a maximum of £70. Liability to pay such costs and expenses will be determined by the Appeal Panel based upon the extent to which the appeal was successful.
- vii. The Appeal Panel may determine the procedures it shall adopt.
- viii. The Appeal Panel Chairman shall notify all concerned of the date, time and place for the appeal, which shall be determined after having due regard to the urgency of the matter and with reasonable regard to the availability of all concerned.
- ix. Upon an appeal being lodged the Disciplinary Officer should provide the Appeal Panel with a written statement setting out:
  - The alleged offence;
  - The proposed penalty;
  - Any justification or explanation that was considered relevant in reaching the decision;
  - The information that was considered in reaching the original decision (e.g. regulations, reports, correspondence etc.).

## Medway Basketball Association — Senior Competition Rules

Participation in a Medway Basketball Association Competitions signifies acceptance of the Competition Rules and agreement to abide by them.

### Trophies

If a winning team wishes to have possession of a trophy a £50.00 Deposit will be payable, refundable upon safe return of the trophy. Trophies must be returned to a Committee Member upon demand.

## General Rules Governing Both the Senior League, Cup, Plate & Rosebowl Competitions

### 1. Rules Governing Matches

- a)** All matches shall be played to FIBA rules except where otherwise stated in these Rules or agreed by the management Committee or Association in General Meeting.
- b)** The Management Committee may make such rulings as it sees fit for the smooth running of the League and Competitions and such rulings shall be binding.

### 2. Fixture Dates

All matches played under the jurisdiction of the Medway Basketball Association shall be played on the dates laid down. Teams will not be allowed to concede fixtures to their opponents.

- a)** However, where the Fixtures/Competitions Secretary (as appropriate) considers it is necessary to change the date of a fixture, he may agree an alternative date – if not the match is forfeit to the team that cannot fulfil it. Retrospective permission may be obtained where there is insufficient time to contact the Fixtures/Competitions Secretary. The unavailability of players will not be an acceptable reason.
- b)** The team initiating the change in date shall be responsible for informing all officials. If there is insufficient time to notify the officials of the postponement before the time scheduled for the tip-off, the team initiating the postponement shall be liable for the officials' fees.
- c)** The team initiating the postponement of a fixture shall be liable for any court fees.
- d)** It is the responsibility of the team initiating the postponement to arrange officials for the re-arranged fixture. The officials originally allocated will not be obliged to officiate at the re-arranged fixture.
- e)** Where the reason for postponement is severe weather conditions, both teams shall share any court fees.

### 3. Duties of the Home Team

The home team shall:

- a) Provide appropriate table equipment, including a score pad, player foul markers, team foul markers, game clock (a small stopwatch is not sufficient), visual scoreboard and proper sounding device. The match referees shall report to the Management Committee if a Club has inadequate equipment.
- b) Change kit in the event of colours clashing.
- c) Be responsible for the payment of any court hire charges.
- d) Provide competent table officials. The match referees shall report to the Management Committee if they do not consider the table officials to be competent.
- e) Send the Fixtures/Competitions Secretary the white copy of the score sheet.

#### 4. Result Notification

The winning team shall notify the Fixtures Secretary or Competitions Secretary of the result of the match by telephone or email promptly – failure to do so will result in them defaulting the match.

The white copy of your scoresheet should be forwarded to the relevant official within **SEVEN** days of the match taking place. Failure to do so will result in a £5.00 fine (see 6. Fines and Penalties for more details).

#### 5. Playing Courts

Each Club must provide its own venue. Matches may only be played on those courts, which have been accepted by all Member Clubs in accordance with England Basketball guidelines regarding insurance.

#### 6. Fines and Penalties

- i. Refereeing Defaults – The following fines will be levied in the event of a refereeing default:
  - a. 1st Default: £20.00 fine
  - b. 2nd Default: £30.00 fine
  - c. 3rd Default: £40.00 fine
  - d. 4th Default: Expulsion from League & Cup Competitions (subject to the Committee's discretion)
- ii. Failure to send a score sheet to the Fixtures/Competitions Secretary to be received within 7 days of the game – £5.00 fine. In addition, if a score sheet is not received within 14 days of the game in the case of a League fixture, a point will be deducted from the League table in respect of the Home team.
- iii. Failure to notify a valid cancellation or postponement within 7 days – £15.00 fine.
- iv. Failure to agree in advance with the Fixtures/Competitions Secretary a new date for a rearranged game – £15.00 fine.
- v. Failure to enter any EBBA registration numbers correctly for players or coaches on a scoresheet – £10.00 fine per scoresheet – this fine will be levied on the home team (which has responsibility for completing the scoresheet), unless the away team has not provided registration numbers, in which case the table official should write “registration numbers not supplied” on the score sheet and the away team will be fined.

- vi. Playing a player who has been registered direct with EB or another area, but whose details have not been provided to the MBA Registrar – £5.00 fine per player and the result of the game will stand.

## **7. Referees**

Each Club will be allocated a number of fixtures for which it will be responsible for providing an independent referee or referees to officiate at. The scoresheet must show which club an official is representing.

## **8. Expenses and Fees for Match Officials**

**a)** Each referee shall receive expenses of £25.00 per match. This must be paid to the referee prior to the start of the match by the Home Team in the case of League Matches and by the Away Team in the case of competitions.

**b)** Should only one Official arrive at a venue that match shall be played, subject to consultation with both teams, at the discretion of that Official and that Official shall receive expenses of £40.00.

**c)** In the case of disputes over the payment of expenses, a referee who travels to a game, having been legitimately requested to do so, but is not required to officiate is entitled to claim the standard fee from the Management Committee. The Management Committee may require such sum to be paid by a member club if it is deemed to be at fault.

## **9. Clubs with More Than One Team**

Notwithstanding Regulation 5, for development purposes, a junior player may play up from a Club's second team to its first team any number of times, in League games only, during a season, unless decided otherwise by the Committee.

## **Additional Rules Governing The Senior League**

### **10. League Season**

The League Season will commence and end on such dates agreed by the Management Committee.

### **11. League Table**

**a)** Two points will be awarded to the winning team of each game; one point will be awarded for a defeat.

**b)** In the event of a withdrawal or expulsion of a team the record of that team shall be deleted from the League Table and the Guarantee Fee shall be forfeit.

**c)** In the event of a team not completing 75% of its fixtures within the cut off date for playing games (30 April unless determined or agreed otherwise by the Committee) its results will be deleted from the League Table and that team shall finish last with zero points.

### **12. Constitution of Divisions**

The Constitution of the Divisions shall be determined by the Management Committee, taking regard where possible of the requests of any Clubs. However, the team finishing last in Division One shall be relegated and the team finishing first in Division Two shall be promoted.

## **Additional Rules Governing The Senior Cup, Plate & Rosebowl Competitions**

### **13. Competition Entry**

All participating teams must play in the Medway Basketball League.

### **14. Match Fees**

The home team shall be responsible for court hire charges, whilst the away team shall be responsible for the referees' fees.

### **15. Players**

Players may only play for one team during any one season.

### **16. Eligibility for Finals**

Players in the finals must have played at least one match in the earlier rounds of the competition.

### **17. Venues for Competition Finals**

The finals of all competitions will be played at neutral venues on dates to be decided by the Competitions Secretary.

### **18. Additional Rules for the Senior Cup & Plate Competitions**

**a)** The first round draw will be seeded, with the first division teams being kept apart from each other, as far as numbers allow.

**b)** The losers of the first round will automatically be entered into the Plate, which will be played alongside the Cup throughout the rest of the season.

### **19. Additional Rules for the Medway Rosebowl ('Handicap' Competition)**

**a)** Handicaps will be decided upon by the Management Committee and will be based on the performances of the current season, up to an agreed cut off date.

**b)** THE HANDICAP IS NOT OPEN TO APPEAL.

**c)** The score at the start of each game is the difference between the handicaps, i.e.. Team A (10) v Team B (42) – starting score 0-32.

**d)** Players must have played a minimum of THREE games before the start of the Rosebowl to be eligible to take part.

### **20. Regulations for Staging Tournaments**

The management Committee shall set such rules as it sees fit for any Tournaments run by or for the Association.

## **Medway Basketball Association: Fair-Play Charter**

The Association, its clubs, officials, competitors and spectators, are perceived by the public as representatives of the sport, and must always attempt to set a good example of sportsmanship and fair play, especially to the younger generation, by the way they carry out their responsibilities both on and off the court.

### **The Association**

- Will ensure that its rules are fair, clearly understood by member clubs, club officials, coaches, players and match officials, and properly enforced.
- Will make every effort to ensure that these rules are applied consistently and with absolute impartiality.
- Will impress upon players and officials the need to maintain the highest standards of sportsmanship in the organisation and playing of basketball.

### **Basketball Players**

- Must abide by the rules and the spirit of the game.
- Must accept the decisions of the referees without question or complaint.
- Must never consider cheating, in particular, must not attempt to improve their individual performance by the use of drugs.
- Must exercise self control at all times.
- Must learn to accept success, failure, victory and defeat, with good grace and magnanimity, and without excessive emotional displays.
- Must treat their opponents and team-mates with due respect, both on and off the court.

### **Member Clubs**

- Must insist that players understand and abide by the principles of good sportsmanship.
- Must never countenance the use of drugs by players.
- Must never employ methods or practices that could involve risks, however, slight, to the long term health or physical development of their players.
- Must not attempt to manipulate the rules in order to take advantage of their players or their opponents.

### **Club Officials**

- Must respect the regulations and authority of the Association and not attempt to avoid or circumvent these regulations.
- Must recognise the special role that they have to play in the establishment of standards by setting a good example of sportsmanship at all times.
- Must respect the rights of other clubs and not deliberately act in a manner intended to be to the detriment of any other club.
- Must respect the rights of players, coaches and officials and not exploit nor deliberately act in a manner intended to be to the detriment of them.
- Must not endeavour to influence the result of a match by any action not strictly within the rules and regulations, or within the fundamental precepts of fair play.

Failure to adhere to this Charter may be considered as evidence of conduct which brings the game into disrepute.

Each season a Fair Play Award will be made to the team which best embodies the spirit of this Charter. The recipient of this award will be determined by a ballot of active referees in the Association's competitions. A Club referee may not vote for their own Club in such ballot.



## Equal Opportunities Statement

The Association has a responsibility for ensuring that all those who wish to participate in its activities are treated fairly and on an equal basis.

In this policy "Discrimination" means discrimination where a person is treated less favourably on grounds of age, gender, marital status, ethnic origin, disability or religious persuasion.

All participants in its activities will be given equal opportunity irrespective of age, gender, marital status, ethnic origin, disability or religious persuasion in all aspects of participation in the sport of basketball.

The Association will ensure avoidance of inequality:

- In the selection, of all those working for, or on behalf of the Association.
- In its rules and regulations.
- In the preparation, production and distribution of all material.
- Through the monitoring of practices, procedures and the operations of its member clubs.

The Association reserves the right to limit competitions to persons of specific age, gender or disability groups to provide opportunity for equal competition.

In formulating its competitions, the Association will seek to ensure that for its part every reasonable effort is made to avoid a format, language or approach which, in relation to a candidate's age, gender, ethnic origin, religious persuasion, or disability:

- Is offensive to members of particular groups.
- Implies stereotyped or biased attitudes.
- Includes terms or concepts or forms of presentation which are unfamiliar to some groups.

In furtherance of this policy, the Association will work in co-operation with any appropriate local organisations and agencies to develop means of identifying and preventing unequal opportunity in relation to participation in sport.

The Association fully supports the principles of equal opportunities and is committed to satisfying these principles in all its activities and in its published material.

The following is an extract from England Basketball's racial equality information and is endorsed by the Association:-

### **"Basketball Rejects Racism**

The game of basketball is one of the most racially harmonious sports played within the United Kingdom and currently enjoys an increasing level of co-operation and participation by multi-ethnic groups.
